

FRANKFURT AM MAIN, GERMANY - On Friday night, the bridge spanning the Oder River between this city and the Polish town of Stuhlice is to be the scene of a lavish party. With fireworks, speeches and mutual congratulations, civic leaders from both sides will celebrate Poland's entry into the European Union.

But many people here aren't celebrating. When Poland, along with nine other nations, joins the EU on Saturday, border
